We work with individuals and groups, schools and young people, and across the private and public sector with the aim of achieving a cleaner, greener and more sustainable Scotland.

And we do this by providing advice and guidance, resources, support, funds as well as inspiration and drive.

We coordinate action and one of our most valuable resources is you, our network.

98% of schools, 250 member organisations of the Sustainable Scotland Network, 1,500 community groups and 158 climate challenge funded groups. This is an incredible, if slightly unwieldy resource and in this next activity I'd like your help in figuring out how we can make the most of that.

Our themes:



Clean Green Sustainable

What do you have? What do you need? (5 mins)

How can we make the most of our network? (10 mins)

So, here is your task: The themes of our work can be broadly categorized as Clean, Green and Sustainable. 1. With these in mind, and considering where your current and potential future interests lie, we are asking you to think about what kinds of support could you benefit from, coming either from Keep Scotland Beautiful or from within our network? We'd like you to start this discussion by considering what you've got going, what you are particularly good at and particularly anything that you think that you could offer our community, be it knowledge, materials or time. Then think about what you need?

2. We'll be asking you to then have a discussion about the best way for your groups to access the support that you need. **How can we all make the best use of our network?** This can be something that you think is vital or a good way of getting information, making connections or fostering collaboration. We'll ask you to pull out your top three to feed back to us.
