

PAWS ON PLASTIC - LITTER PICK CHALLENGE

Can you help protect animals, communities & our precious environment by picking up some litter on walks? Or by organising your own family litter pick?

- · You will need a LITTER PICKER, a BAG and a pair of GLOVES.
- On walks use your litter picker to collect any litter that you find and put it in your bag. Could any of it (like plastic bottles & cans) be recycled? Keep a tally of the types of things that you pick up. **Please remember to always take care & make sure that you have a responsible adult with you. DON'T touch any broken glass or any items contaminated with human waste e.g. nappies these should be reported to your local council for safe disposal.
