3. What is the meeting in Glasgow about climate change called?

It's called COP26 which is short for Conference of the Parties. The 2021 meeting will be the 26th meeting, which is why it's called COP26.

It will be attended by countries that signed the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) - a treaty agreed in 1994.
