P3 to S2 Awareness survey

The questions in this survey have been adapted from: Salazar, G., Kunkle, K. & Monroe, M. C. (2020) <u>Practitioner guide to assessing connection to nature</u>. Washington, DC: North American Association for Environmental Education.

How to conduct the survey:

The survey should take about 15 minutes to complete. The survey is composed of a series of agree/disagree statements for pupils to complete. You can complete the survey in a group asking each question and recording responses in the summary table below. Alternatively, you can use the survey sheet on page 3 for pupils to complete individually.

On page 2 there are five open ended questions to enable pupils to express their thoughts further and to help generate ideas for your Action Plan.

You can read the following text to explain how the survey will work to your pupils:

'We want to know what you think about some things. There are no right or wrong answers. Just be honest about the way you feel. After I read each sentence, you will have five choices: Strongly Disagree (two thumbs down), Disagree (one thumb down), Not Sure (question mark), Agree (one thumb up) and Strongly Agree (two thumbs up). Select the one that best describes how you feel about each statement.'
