All the work Lauder in Bloom have done to beautify their town has not gone unnoticed – in fact, it's the complete opposite! In 2024, they were nominated by Keep Scotland Beautiful to represent Scotland in the UK RHS Britain in Bloom finals competition for the very first time.



In 2023, Lauder in Bloom were recognised for their fantastic achievements and efforts over the year with a Beautiful Scotland gold medal certificate, won the Best Large Village Award and a further two discretionary awards: the David Welch Memorial Award for Something Special and the Keep Scotland Beautiful Award.
