- ✓ Practical actions you can take to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and help future-proof your business, organisation, and homelife.

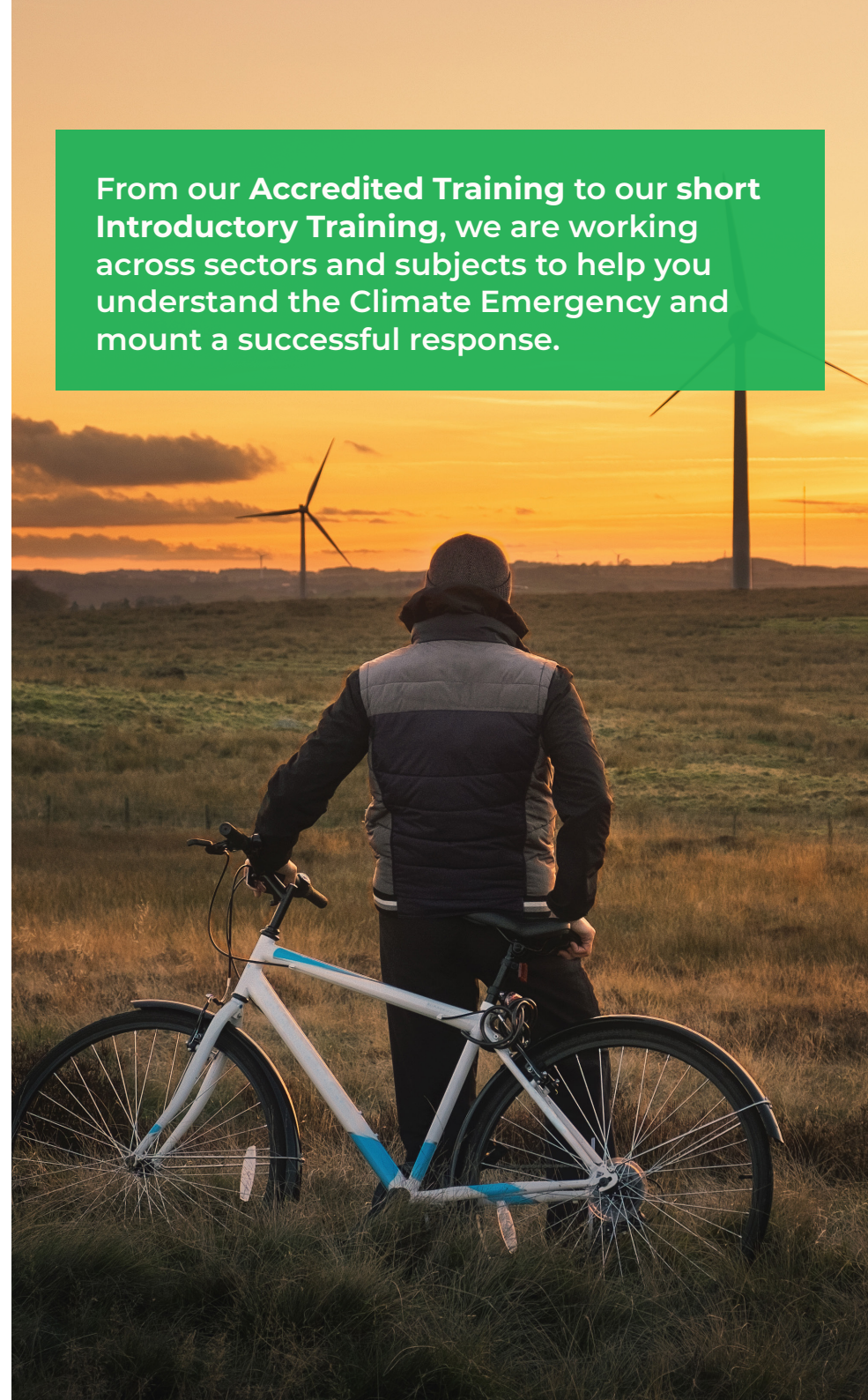

Introductory Training

Webinars and workshops

We also offer a more in-depth 2.5 hour workshop, which provides options to work with us and insert your own materials, and have participants receive a certificate of attendance from Keep Scotland Beautiful.

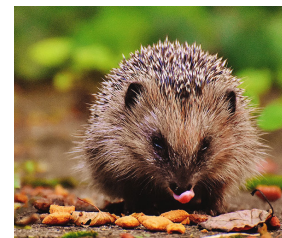
