"East Haven Together has achieved a community led Scotland's Beach Award from Keep Scotland Beautiful every year since 2016. Erosion is a widespread issue which constantly creates new challenges but we have created a coastal adaptation programme and planted Lyme and Marram grass helping strengthen the dunes and increase biodiversity.
