Spring was Bright with Daffodils from the start of Eyemouth to the end.



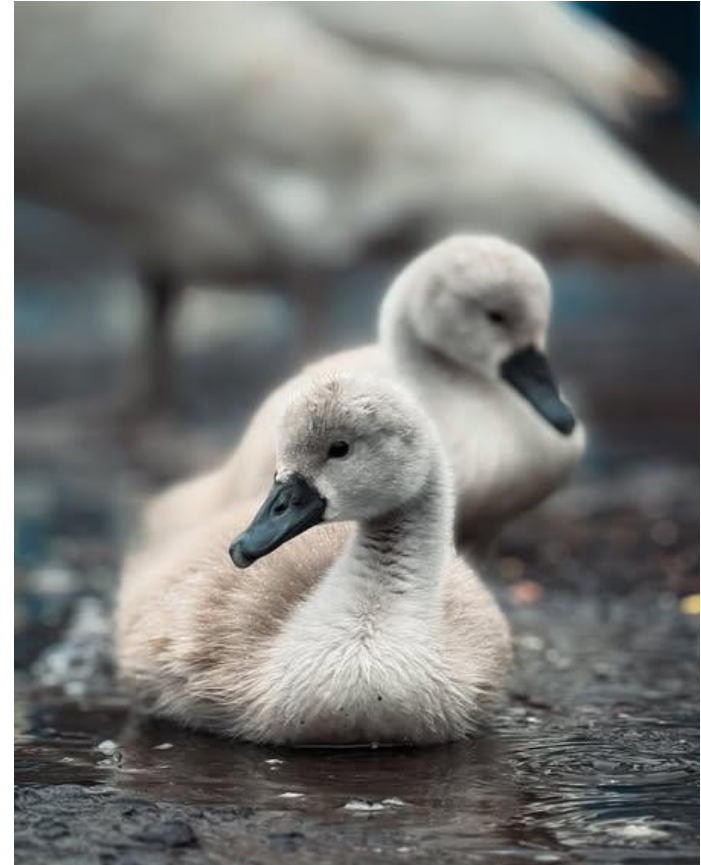

Local groups keep our home clean and tidy.



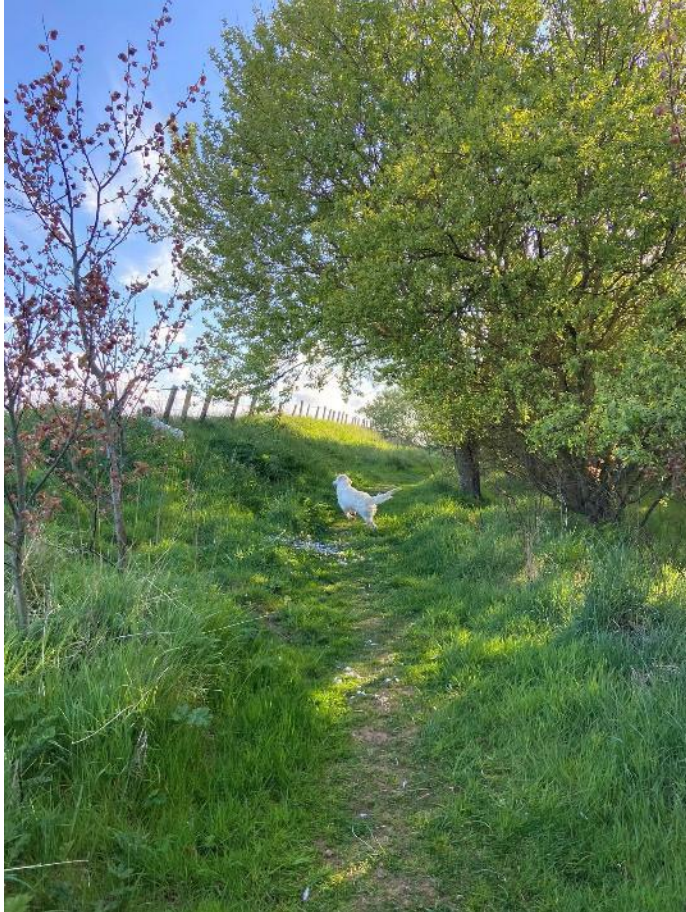
The Nursery made a snake while we sowed seeds donated by EDF.
