We want to keep Scotland beautiful and we'd love you to help us

We're committed to tackling litter as we work towards achieving our vision for a clean, green, sustainable Scotland. Our mission is to inspire changes in behaviour to improve our environment, the quality of people's lives, their wellbeing and the places that they care for.

We declared a litter emergency based on evidence from our public perception surveys and our ground litter audits. Our two latest reports <u>How clean are our streets?</u> and the <u>Scottish Litter</u>. <u>Survey</u>, published in November 2023, continue to evidence the challenge. Crucially the reports highlight that 90% of people agree that litter is a problem across the country, while 70% of people believe that litter is a problem in their local area.

Scotland is beautiful. But we can't take it for granted.





Spring Clean Scotland

Spring Clean Scotland is our flagship annual litter campaign. It is one of the largest campaigns in Scotland that inspires and mobilises individuals from across all sectors to take action on litter collaboratively.

We have a track record of working with small and large businesses to deliver successful campaigns. With Spring Clean being a recognised part of our calendar to inspire community groups, schools, and local authority partners, we want to offer businesses the opportunity to be part of making Spring Clean Scotland 2025 our most successful yet.
