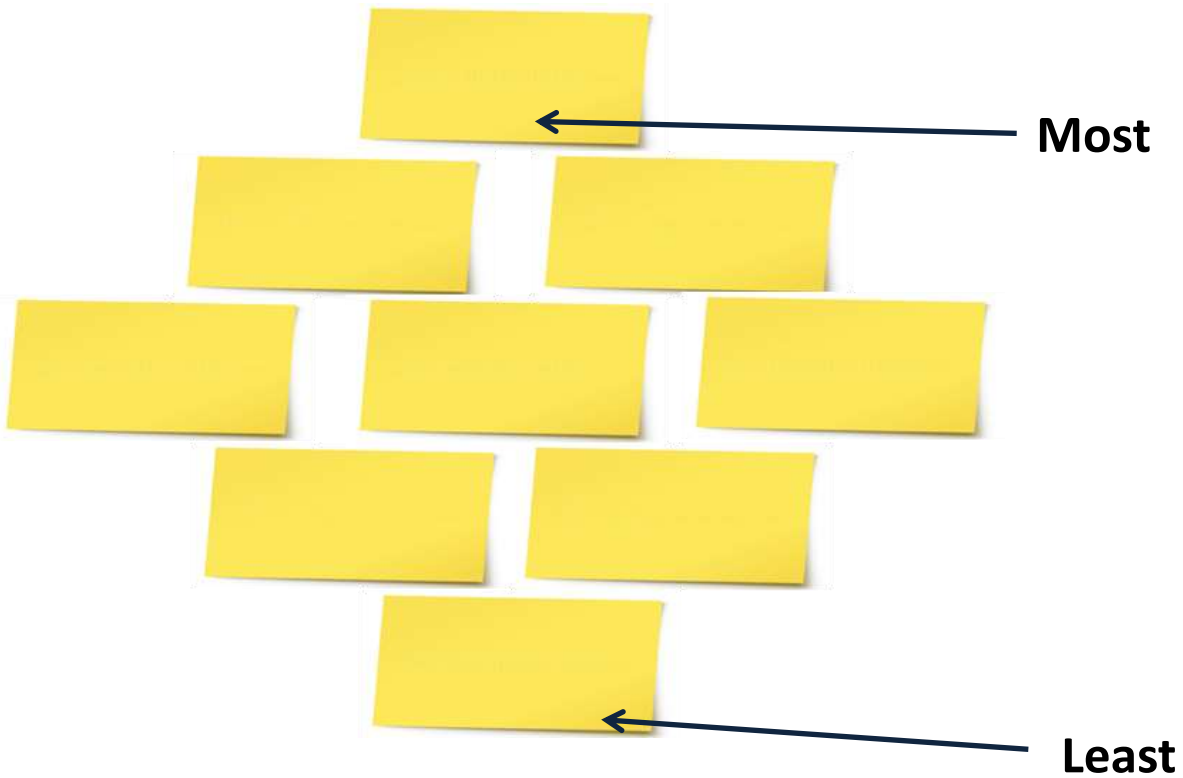


In this activity participants are asked to arrange nine pieces of evidence of climate change into a diamond shape according to how useful they think they will be for communicating with people in their community. You could swap in and out different pieces of evidence based on your own research (e.g. the effect on local wildlife, local flooding, etc.)
