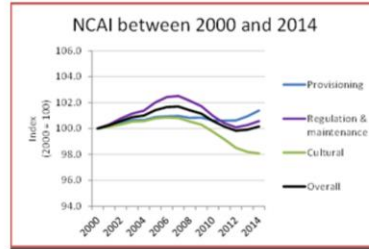

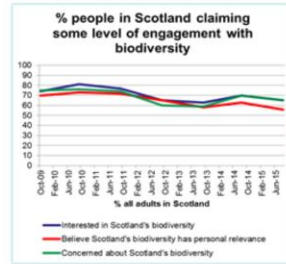


Key drivers of biodiversity change
