

Registration Terms and Conditions

Beautiful Scotland is operated by Keep Scotland Beautiful, incorporated under the Companies Acts (company number SC206984, Scottish charity number SC030332) and having its registered office at 1st Floor, Strathallan House, Castle Business Park, Stirling, FK9 4TZ.

By registering with the campaign, you and your organisation / group agree that:

1. Keep Scotland Beautiful reserves the right to publish portfolios and related materials in order to share good practice with other groups within the campaigns, including publication on the Keep Scotland Beautiful and Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) websites.
