## About

- Wild Thyme is one of the most widespread and abundant of the thyme species. It's a great evergreen herb which is available all year round. It goes well with other herbs, especially rosemary, and works well with meat and in stews and casseroles.

## Planting instructions

- Thyme is best cultivated in a sunny location with well-drained soil.
- Plant in the spring.
- Seeds, cuttings or divided root sections of the plant can be used for propagating.
- Thyme tolerates drought well.

## Care

- Fast growing, resistant, requires little care.
